






Accommodation







ARACHOVA

Perched at an elevation of approximately 950 meters, the town offers breathtaking panoramic views of the surrounding mountainous landscapes.


Renowned for its close proximity to the ancient archaeological site of Delphi, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Arachova serves as an ideal gateway for those exploring the historical wonders of the region.

Delphi, an ancient sanctuary considered the navel of the world in Greek mythology, adds to the cultural richness of the area.

















Delphi Museum & Archaeological Site

The Delphi Archaeological Museum, a repository of artifacts that unveils the richness of ancient Delphi. Among its treasures is the Sphinx of Naxos, an imposing marble sculpture, and the iconic Charioteer of Delphi, a bronze masterpiece commemorating a Pythian Games victor. The museum's collection includes a diverse array of statues, pottery, and dedications, providing a comprehensive view of ancient Greek artistic and religious expression.

Dedications from various city-states, inscriptions, and artifacts offer insights into the religious and political tapestry of Delphi. Visitors to Delphi, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, embark on a journey through time, exploring not only the archaeological remnants but also the cultural and spiritual significance that defined this ancient sanctuary.

Delphi's accessibility by road, approximately 180 kilometers northwest of Athens, makes it a compelling destination for those seeking a profound connection with Greece's rich heritage.
